REVIEW

**PROCLAMATION** (*noun*):

1. the act of proclaiming; the state of being proclaimed
2. something proclaimed; a clear declaration of something
  - *specifically*: an official formal public announcement, especially one dealing with a matter of great importance

# 2025: THE YEAR OF PROCLAMATION

REVIEW

**PROCLAIM** (*verb*):

1. announce officially or publicly
  - declare something one considers important with due emphasis
  - declare officially or publicly to be
  - demonstrate or indicate clearly

Latin Origin:

*pro* + *clamare* → *proclamare*  
"forth"      "to shout"      "to shout or cry out" / "to herald"

## 1 / Anointed to Proclaim

ISAIAH 61:1-3

<sup>1</sup> The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to **proclaim good news** to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to **proclaim freedom for the captives & release from darkness** for the prisoners [*LXX*: the blind], <sup>2</sup> to **proclaim the Year of the LORD's Favor & the Day of Vengeance of our God**, to **comfort all who mourn**, <sup>3</sup> & provide for those who grieve in Zion—to bestow on them a crown of **beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, & a garment of praise** instead of a spirit of despair. **They will be called oaks of righteousness, a planting of the LORD for the display of His splendor.**

*Luke 4:14-21*

### ***In Luke Chapter 3...***

*John baptized Jesus in water, the Holy Spirit descended as a dove upon Him, & the Voice of the Father affirmed Him as the Son.*

### ***In Luke 4:1-13...***

*The Holy Spirit led Jesus into the wilderness, where He fasted & prayed for 40 days & nights & successfully resisted the temptations of the devil.*

<sup>14</sup> Jesus returned to Galilee **in the power of the Spirit**, & **news about Him spread** through the whole countryside. <sup>15</sup> He was teaching in their synagogues, & everyone praised Him. <sup>16</sup> He went to Nazareth, where He had been brought up, & on the Sabbath day He went into the synagogue, as was His custom. He stood up to read, <sup>17</sup> & **the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to Him. Unrolling it, He found the place** where it is written: <sup>18</sup> *"The Spirit of the Lord is on Me, because **He has anointed Me to proclaim***

**Good News** *to the poor. He has sent Me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners & recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free,*<sup>19</sup> *to proclaim the Year of the Lord's Favor..."*<sup>20</sup> Then He rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant & sat down. The eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fastened on Him.<sup>21</sup> He began by saying to them, "**Today this scripture is fulfilled in your hearing.**"

### 3 / Accepted to Prevail

LUKE 4:22-30

<sup>22</sup> **All spoke well of Him** & were amazed at the gracious words that came from His lips. "Isn't this Joseph's son?" they asked. <sup>23</sup> Jesus said to them, "Surely **you will quote this proverb to Me: 'Physician, heal yourself!'** [*cf. Lk 23:35*] And you will tell Me, 'Do here in your hometown what we have heard that You did in Capernaum.'" <sup>24</sup> Truly I tell you," He continued, "no prophet is accepted in his hometown. <sup>25</sup> I assure you that there were many widows in Israel in Elijah's time, when the sky was shut for three & a half years & there was a severe famine throughout the land. <sup>26</sup> Yet Elijah was not sent to any of them, but to a widow in Zarephath in the

region of Sidon *[see 1 Kg 17:8-24]*.<sup>27</sup> And there were many in Israel with leprosy in the time of Elisha the prophet, yet not one of them was cleansed—only Naaman the Syrian" *[see 2 Kg 5:1-14]*.<sup>28</sup> **All the people in the synagogue were furious when they heard this.** <sup>29</sup> They got up, drove Him out of the town, & took Him to the brow of the hill on which the town was built, **in order to throw Him off the cliff.** <sup>30</sup> But **He walked right through the crowd & went on His way.**
